

More CMP Tree trimming coming to Belfast in 2010.

CMP representatives advised the city that they would be doing additional tree trimming in the City this year on different streets than last year. Enclosed is the list of streets they intend to cut on. The cutting is required of CMP by the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) and is intended to cut back and reduce the number of power outages arising from trees hitting power lines.

CMP will trim a “minimum” of 8’ on the sides of lines, a “minimum” of 15’ above the lines and also cut trees that are directly underneath the lines. They do not stop and talk to every household before they cut along these streets.

The ONLY WAY for homeowners to have contact with the cutters in advance of cutting is for the owner to contact CMP by one of the 2 following ways:
