City Manager, Erin Herbig noted that if the City Council approves to change its plan for its full-time Police Union employee the City would:

a) Provide Special Plan 3C to its full-time police officers for service rendered after June 30, 2020. Service rendered prior to July 1, 2020 remains under Special Plan 2C.

b) Continue to provide Regular Plan AC to all other full-time employees and its elected/appointed officials.

c) To authorize (Name and Title of City Manager/Administrator or Names and Titles of City Council members) to sign the Amended Agreement between the City and the Maine Public Employees Retirement System.

Councilor Mortier, seconded by Councilor Bonneville, made approve the Maine State Retirement Plan Change for the Police Union Employees, as presented. This motion was approved, 5-0.

Councilor Bonneville, seconded by Councilor Harkness, made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:24 p.m. This motion was approved, 5-0.


