



- # 2 Plastics-

-Please look on the bottom of container for the #2 inside the recycle logo:

ALL MUST BE CLEAN!

- #s 1 & 3 -7 Plastics -

Food, Yogurt, Condiment, & Plastic Egg Containers. Salad Dressing Bottles, Lids and Caps, 5 Gallon Pails, Butter Tubs, & Cleaning Product Containers.

-Rigid Plastics -

ARE NO LONGER RECYCLED

(these items may still be dropped off at demo pile)

This includes:

Plastic Buckets, Milk/Soda Crates, Laundry Baskets, Lawn Furniture, Toys, Landscape and Microwave Trays. Plastic Drums, Shelving, Dish Drainers, Flower Pots, Automotive (Plastic bumpers, bed-liners, grills, hub-caps, etc.), & Garbage Cans.
