The Belfast Police Department working with community partners is developing a new database to serve individuals with Alzheimer's, Autism, and other conditions that can make them prone to wander:

- Photos of the individual allow officers to more easily identify him or her if they do get lost
- Saves valuable time when **seconds** count
- Alerts officers to potential triggers and ways to calm the individual
- Enables family members or caregivers to be notified promptly when the person has been found





