

PROJECT UPDATE WIGHT STREET ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

May 13, 2024

Nitram Construction has begun work on the Wight Street Roadway project. They will be installing a new piped drainage system on Wight Street from Northport Avenue up to Congress Street, then replacing all the gravel and pavement on Wight Street, as well as constructing a multiuse pathway along the north side of the road. There is also a small section of Congress Street between the bypass and Wight Street where sanitary sewer is being installed.

During the construction, which is expected to be completed in August, there will be daily roadway closures to through traffic. Local traffic (which is defined as those living on or having business on Wight Street) may expect delays, but will generally be able to access their destination on Wight Street from one end of the road. The location of work and road blockage will change daily. It is encouraged that vehicles avoid the construction area unless they need to be on Wight Street.
